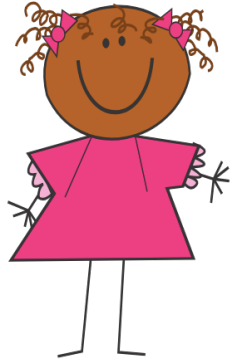


CHALLENGE 1
